If you come to God for HEALING. You MUST believe that He is ABLE and that He is WILLING to heal you. Hebrews 11:6 Pastor Thad "Wherefore remember, that ye being in time past Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands; That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world: But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ."

Ephesians 2:11-13

his is an amazing Scripture. It makes it clear that we have access to everything that God has because of the blood of Jesus. The blood of Jesus has brought us into COVENANT with God. Where we used to be separated and even aliens from God's promises (as Gentiles), we are now brought right smack dab in the middle of every covenant promise.

Galatians 3:13 tell us that we have been redeemed from the curse because of what happened on the cross, by Jesus. Not only BOUGHT out of the curse, but BROUGHT into the blessing of God and everything that it contains. Deuteronomy 28 makes it very clear about what is included in the blessing and even what is included under the curse.

Because of the blood of Jesus...we get the blessing. Praise God!

The crazy thing is when you read what is included under the curse it is clear that sickness and disease is a part of the curse. Therefore, under the blessing is healing and health.



Not only BOUGHT OUT of the curse. but BROUGHT INTO the

BLESSING OF GOD and everything that it contains.

- Vs. 27 "The LORD will smite you with the boils of Egypt and with tumors and with the scab and with the itch, from which you cannot be healed.
- Vs. 28 "The LORD will smite you with madness and with blindness and with bewilderment of heart;
- Vs. 29 And you will grope at noon, as the blind man gropes in darkness, and you will not prosper in your ways; but you shall only be oppressed and robbed continually, with none to save you.
- Vs. 35 "The LORD will strike you on the knees and legs with sore boils, from which you cannot be healed, from the sole of your foot to the crown of your head.
- Vs. 59 then the LORD will bring extraordinary plagues on you and your descendants, even severe and lasting plagues, and miserable and chronic sicknesses.
- Vs. 60 "He will bring back on you all the diseases of Egypt of which you were afraid, and they will cling to you.
- Vs. 61 "Also every sickness and every plague which, not written in the book of this law, the LORD will bring on you until you are destroyed.

A couple quick points from these passages:

- When it says God is going to do something, the correct interpretation from the Hebrew language is that God will allow these things to happen. He doesn't cause it, He allows it because of you being under the curse.
- Notice how many times it says things like sickness will cling to you, you cannot be healed or will pursue you. That does not sound good.

However, we must remember that Galatians 3:13 tells us that we've been redeemed from these things. They do NOT belong to

us. We have been bought out and brought in to the blessings (health) because of covenant.

Importance of Covenant

The definition of covenant relationships that the Lord gave to me years ago is: An intimate, intricate and binding relationship between two or more people that unites their strengths in order to eliminate their weaknesses.

God wants us strong...not weak. So, He made a covenant with us in order to eliminate our weaknesses and allow us to tap into ALL of His benefits (Psalm 103).

Now, when we focus on what covenant is it is important that we focus on those first three words, that the Lord gave to me, in the definition.

INTRICATE: There are a lot of elements that are essential to walk in covenant, things like integrity, faithfulness, loyalty, the words of your mouth, plus many more. It is more than just a quick, "Hey, let's be in covenant," and then forget about it later. Now, I won't focus on this point in this article, but it is essential to understand... especially in understanding the character of God.

BINDING: Another key aspect is to understand that there is NO BACKING out of covenant. It is even more than a lifelong agreement...it lasts for generations. In the Word, God tells us that His covenants last forever (which is a long time). The most important thing about this aspect is that if you break covenant, you fail...and God never fails.

Psalm 89:34 - "My covenant will I not break, nor altar the thing that is gone out of my lips."

Therefore, when something is given to us under covenant with God...it means that there is NOTHING that will change God's heart regarding that thing. When it comes to healing...God is not changing His mind for you or any of His children.

So, if God spoke it thousands of years ago...it is still a promise today. It is still under the blood and it is still ours. Healing is ours because of the blood.

INTIMATE: Covenant is personal. It is relational. When it comes to the covenant of healing, it is personal with God to want His kids healed, healthy and strong. God spoke to Kenneth Copeland and

simply said, "I want my people well."

Notice God calls us HIS PEOPLE! That is taking ownership of us and our health. That is relationship. That is covenant talk. God wants us healed because we are His!

In Psalm 103:4 it tells us that one of our benefits are His tender mercies. That Hebrew word is the word Racham, which is a love of a mother for her child. A love that is given, not because of anything that a person has done, but because of the simple fact that the lover has taken ownership of the object of his love...nothing more, nothing less.

God's covenant of healing isn't because of anything that you have done, but just because God loves you. That's it. Wow!

That is why He says things like this,

3 John 2 - "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth."

Psalm 17:8 - "Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings."

When you understand that in Malachi 4:2 we are told that God has healing in His wings...that means we get to partake in healing, because we are the apple of His eyes.

God's Covenant Love

In Psalm 23:6 it tells us, "Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life...." It is important that we remember a couple of these words so that we understand the magnitude what this verse is telling us.

To **"follow"** doesn't mean to just lazily stay behind someone. It is actually a hunting term in the Hebrew language. It means to set your sights on something or someone and HUNT them down. So, when it comes to His sheep, goodness and mercy are not just strolling behind you to see how you are doing. They are going after you.

Then there is the word **"goodness"**. It is the Hebrew word towb. It literally means good in the widest and deepest sense of the term. Good as good can get. To take phrase from the New Testament, towb would be, "good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over" good. So God, because of our covenant with Him, has given goodness the job of chasing us down.

That leaves us with "mercy". This word is also listed in Psalm 103:4 under the benefits of Almighty God. It is the Hebrew word chesed, which is defined as covenant love. It is the love of God given to us through blood covenant. It is His favor and honor being shown to us because we are in covenant relationship with Him. This is important to understand, God's covenant love (which includes healing) is not some passive thing that hopes to meet up with you at some point. It is chasing you down, to have its way with you. To do what covenant healing does.

In 2 Chronicles 20, the Moabites and Ammonites gathered together to go to war against Israel. Their army was much larger and more imposing than Israel's army. Jehoshaphat, Israel's king, had fear come after him (natural reaction) after hearing the report of the size of the opposition. However, instead of focusing on the size of the enemy...he began to call on the covenant with Yahweh. He was reminded of the blood covenant with Almighty God.

Here is how God responded to him, "And he said, Hearken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus saith the LORD unto you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's" (vs. 15). In other words, the enemy may be too big for you, but it is not too big for your covenant partner...so your covenant partner is going to fight this battle.

God continued to give Jehoshaphat, and his armies, directions for the battle. It may have seemed crazy, but God said to put the singers out in front of the armies and have them sing this song, "Praise the Lord, for his CHESED endureth forever." He literally told them to go into battle and SING loudly about their covenant with Him. That is exactly what they did. They sang out about God's covenant with them and God showed up and defeated the enemy.

Beloved, that is the exact point I want us to see...God has given us a covenant of healing. Psalm 103:2 tells us to make sure we don't

forget it. So, whether you need to sing about it, talk about it, read about it, or even dream about it...keep God's blood covenant with you at the front of your mind.

HEALING is a part

The physical battle that you are facing may seem as imposing as

the battle that Israel was facing in 2 Chronicles 20. Maybe to you it is MORE imposing or far scarier, but the blood covenant that God has made with us, through the blood of Jesus, is still there...still working...still chasing you down to have its way with you.

Your key is to keep your mind on it...keep calling on it...don't forget it. Don't let up. Healing is a part of God's covenant with you so enjoy it. Jesus fought the battle for you, on the cross. You get to live in healing and health.

For You To Consider

Exodus 2:23-25 – The children of Israel were in bondage for 430 years in Egypt. It seemed to get worse and worse, until they called on the covenant between God and Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

Mark 10:46-52 - The blind man.

What exactly did he call on? He called on the mercy (chesed) of God. He fully intended of receiving his healing when he called on God's covenant with him.

Matthew 15:21-28 - Syrophoenician woman She was not a Jew. She had no covenant between her and God. However, when she came for the healing of her daughter she reminded Him of His mercy, and called on it and received the healing.

o understand covenant is to understand that a covenant partner's word is their bond. Where there is no trust in what someone says, there can be no covenant with that person. Because God is a Covenant Keeper He declares that His Word is forever settled in the heavens (Psalm 119:89) and also says that He sets His Word above His name (Psalm 138:2). So if He says something, we can absolutely believe that it will come to pass. Let's see what the Word of God says about healing!

Exodus 15:26 (KJV)

"And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee."

Exodus 23:25,26 (KJV)

- 25 And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.
- 26 There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil.

Exodus 23:25,26 (NLT)

- 25 "You must serve only the LORD your God. If you do, I will bless you with food and water, and I will protect you from illness.
- 26 There will be no miscarriages or infertility in your land, and I will give you long, full lives.

Deuteronomy 7:14,15 (KJV)

- 14 Thou shalt be blessed above all people: there shall not be male or female barren among you, or among your cattle.
- 15 And the LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all them that hate thee.
