

Romans 12:12 - Patient in Tribulation

Message preached on Wednesday, April 30th and Wednesday, May 7th, 2025

12 Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer;

Last week we began in Romans 12:12 with three directions that we need to operate in...

1.) Rejoice (back up and get another load) in HOPE (expectation/confidence). Go over "A Couple Extra Verses" from above.

Patient in Tribulation

LET'S START with the last first...

- "Tribulation" pressure, persecution, tribulation, trouble, burdened down
 - This is defining the place where we need to be patient in...when the pressure hits...when the trials come.
 - **NOTE:** This is a different term, overall, from the one we find in James, but it really means the same things...temptations, tests and trials.

QUESTION: What do we do when the pressure hits? **ANSWER:** Be patient.

- I find it interesting that when Matthew 24 is defining when Jesus returns...and the GREAT TRIBULATION...he uses this word.
- **IN OTHER WORDS:** This is some pressure. This is when things are not going right. It isn't the GREAT TRIBULATION...but it is tribulation.

QUESTION: You want to stay around and experience the GREAT tribulation?

ANSWER: Nope! So give your life to Christ today!

I mean, if you are struggling during was is considered only tribulation...you want to make sure you are OUT OF HERE for the GREAT tribulation.

How about another picture of this word:

<u>John 16:21</u> – "A woman when she is in travail hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, *she remembereth no more the anguish*, for joy that a man is born into the world."

Contractions of birth!

HERE IS A COOL THING: What is the point about birth? The contractions? The rest of the verse: You don't remember anymore because of your baby!

UNDERSTAND: When we understand the place of tribulations/pressure...we can see them as places we need to BACK UP AND GET ANOTHER LOAD of joy! Because what is coming is going to be AMAZING!

<u>John 16:33</u> – "These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the *world ye shall have tribulation*: but *be of good cheer*; I have overcome the world."

The promise is coming!

- <u>Mark 4:17</u> (seed sown on stony ground) "And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, *when affliction* or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended."
- RECOGNIZE why affliction comes...to steal the Word...to take your harvest!
- **We MUST** lay down our flesh and renew our mind...so we are able to stay PATIENT in the middle of pressure and tribulations.

NOW: What are we suppose to do in the middle of this pressure/tribulation/burden?

- "*Patient*" is the root of the word patient in James 1:3 (constancy); but that same application can be made here.
- **DEFINITION:** to endure, to stay, to have fortitude.

REMEMBER: The picture we have in James 1:3 is to be constant...don't quit...keep doing what you've been doing!

Think of Mark and the seed – does the farmer quit because it is dry? Nope! You water it.

Think of a mother in labor – does she quit because of the pain? Nope! Keep pushing! **NOTE:** For nine months you listened to the doctor...don't stop now!

This WORD is basically telling us to stick with it...don't quit. Endure.

Don't stop listening to the Word NOW!

Hebrews 10:32,33

- 32 But call to remembrance the former days, in which, *after ye were illuminated*, ye **endured** a great fight of **afflictions**;
- 33 Partly, whilst ye were made a gazingstock both by reproaches and *afflictions*; and partly, whilst ye became **companions** of them that were so used.
 - (AMP) "Sometimes being yourselves a gazingstock, publicly exposed to insults *and* abuse and distress, and *sometimes claiming fellowship and making common cause with others who were so treated.*"

NOTE: It doesn't stop there

Hebrews 10:35-39

- 35 Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.
- 36 For ye have need of **patience**, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.
- 37 For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry.
- 38 Now *the just shall live by faith*: but *if any man draw back*, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.
- 39 But we are not of them **who draw back unto perdition**; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.

Hebrews 12:2 - tells us Jesus ENDURED the cross. Didn't fluctuate!

<u>James 1:12</u> – "Blessed (supremely blessed, fortunate, well off, happy) is the man that **endureth temptation:** for when he is tried, he shall **receive the crown of life**, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him."

NOTE: Many think this only has to do with HEAVEN.

But this literally means awards...rewards of ZOE!

<u>1 Corinthians 9:24</u> – "Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain."

RUN...don't quit.

Philippians 3:12-14

- 12 Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.
- 13 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,
- 14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

BELOVED: When you are in the middle of battles...struggles. Keep running! Keep pushing! Keep watering! Don't quit.
