# The **LORD** Has Done **GREAT THINGS** for Us!

*Message preached on Sunday Morning, December 14, 2025*

## Word of Our Testimony

There was a period of time, in the Old Covenant, that God's people were NOT doing what they were suppose to do. Disobedience...worshipping other gods...etc.

When God's hand leaves you...you are in serious trouble and God's hand left them.

They were taken captive by the Babylonians...for 70 years, while their home land was in ruins.

During those 70 years...they cried out to God for help...for 70 years it seemed like nothing good happened...except for a lion's den and a fiery furnace.

**HOWEVER:** There were those crying out for repentance and turning their hearts towards God.

**LONG STORY SHORT...**God moved and the people were released to go back to their homeland and rebuild it.

During that time...this song was written.

It was a joyful song regarding this return.

Psalm 126:1-6

- 1 When the LORD turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream.
- 2 Then was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing: then said they among the heathen, The LORD hath done great things for them.
- 3 ***The LORD hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad.***
- 4 Turn again our captivity, O LORD, as the streams in the south.
- 5 They that sow in tears shall reap in joy.
- 6 He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.

This is the seventh of fifteen songs of Ascent for the Jews.

**IN OTHER WORDS:** Whenever they would travel back to Jerusalem for the feasts (Passover, Pentecost and Tabernacles) they would sing these songs over and over again....***REMEMBERING God's faithfulness and goodness—EXPECTING more of the same!***

AS I was reading through this Psalm...vs. 3 rose up inside of me.

***“The Lord has done great things FOR US; whereof we are glad!”***

I want you to notice something...that is the statement that their future RIDES ON! Yep! ***It is one of the most important Truths we will understand!***

Verse 1 and 2 – What God did in the returning from Babylon.

Verve 3 – Remembering and JOY!

Verse 4-6 – Expectation for more!

**BELOVED:** If He has done it ONCE...He will do it again! If He had done it for OTHERS...He will do it for you!

There is power in your testimony...or WHAT HAS ALREADY HAPPENED.

Revelation 12:11 – “And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.”

**DISCUSS:** vs. 10 – Accuser of the brethren.

**QUESTION:** How was the enemy (accuser of the brethren) overcome?

- 1.) Blood of the Lamb.
- 2.) Word of their testimony.

## The Blood of the Lamb

Hebrews 6:16-19

- 16 For men verily swear by the greater: and an ***oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife.***
- 17 Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, ***confirmed it by an oath:***
  - ~ Covenant in Blood
  - ~ Oath of Promise
- 18 That by ***two immutable things***, in which it was impossible for God to lie, ***we might have a strong consolation***, who have fled for refuge to lay ***hold upon the hope set before us:***

Numbers 23:19 – “God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?”

- 19 ***Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul***, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

**NOTICE:** Anchor for our soul.

James 1:6,7

- 6 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.
- 7 For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.

**UNDERSTAND:** The blood of the LAMB has overcome the enemy.

**AGAIN:** The Lord has done great things for us. Because of the BLOOD...there is nothing the enemy can do...***he can't cross that line!***

***“The Lord has done great things FOR US; whereof we are glad!”***

**REMEMBER:** The only way the enemy can do anything to us is to convince us through our mind/will/ emotions to stop short...to quit...to disobey.

BUT remembering the BLOOD...keeps us from believing his lies.

***The blood is our anchor!***

## Conclusion

The Lord spoke this to me a couple services ago and it really got my attention:

*What God has done for us...*

***“The Lord has done great things FOR US; whereof we are glad!”***

*...is our confidence for what He is going to do.*

Philippians 1:6 – “Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:”

Hebrews 10:35 – “Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.”

Romans 4 – Abraham finally got to the point that he was confident in the covenant and confident in the oath (staggered not)...the promise came!
