### **Sunday, April 2, 2023 - Pastor Mike Goldey**

Philippians 4:19

**“riches”** - external possession, physical possessions

**LITERALLY:** filthy stinking rich, bursting at the seams

**RICK RENNER TRANSLATION:** “But my God will supply your needs so completely that He will eliminate all your deficiencies; He will meet all your physical and tangible needs until you are so full that you have no more capacity to hold anything else. He will supply all your needs until you are totally filled, packed full and overflowing to the point of bursting at the seams and spilling over!”

Malachi 3:10 - It takes something to get to this point!

### **Wednesday, April 5, 2023 - Pastor Alisa Bailey**

Judges 16:6-16 - Samson and Delilah

Delilah kept asking how he can be bound physically.

Every step Samson gets closer to the truth, because she kept badgering him.

He didn't see her tricks because he loved Delilah.

**QUESTION:** What is your Delilah when it comes to your finances? What is the area that the enemy can get you? Tithe? Sowing? Consistency? Economy? Gas prices? Unexpected bills?

Whatever it is...the enemy will keep attacking you in order to get you to stop giving...to take you out!

### **Sunday, April 9, 2023 - Pastor Mike Goldey**

2 Corinthians 9:5-10

Make sure you have the right attitude in your giving.

Often we can feel like our pastor is just trying to get our money...but God is trying to get YOU!

Vs. 5 - God prepares your bounty.

Vs. 6 - How you sow determines how you receive.

Vs. 7 - Not grudgingly (right attitude) or out of necessity (duty). A willing offering!

Vs. 10 - Multiplies seed sown (make sure you have more to give).

### **Wednesday, April 12, 2023 - Pastor Alisa Bailey**

Deuteronomy 28:24 (NASB)

1 Kings 17:1-6 - This is the first mention, in the Bible, of Elijah.

Vs. 3,4 - Word is spoken to him.

Vs. 5,6 - He did what was spoken to him.

**QUESTION:** What did Elijah think/feel about his supply? Excited? It has been in raven's mouths.

Perhaps excited at first...then not so much?

When God told him to move...he moved...God supplied! God still provides...He hasn't stopped! He is faithful! He takes care of ALL THINGS. Get excited about how God is still providing for you.

We can get caught up in what WE NEED TO SUPPLY, instead of what God supplies.

### **Sunday, April 16, 2023 - Pastor Mike Goldey**

Psalms 34:7-10

Vs. 8 - taste and see; Vs. 9 - no lack to those who fear Him; Vs. 10 - no lack

God is trying to get us to a place of extreme blessing...wealth. But we must fear Him...connect to His ways.

Matthew 6:33 - Seek His ways first.

### **Wednesday, April 19, 2023 - Pastor Alisa Bailey**

Luke 16:11

**(NASB)** - "...use of unrighteous wealth..."

**RICK RENNER TRANSLATION:** "If you are impetuous, thoughtless, rash, irresponsible, and untrustworthy with regular ol' money and all of its buying power in this earthly realm, who will commit to your trust the indisputable, true, bona fide riches?"

When it comes to your money...pay your bills on time...pay your tithes on time...be responsible with your regular ol' money.

If you want all that God has for you, you must be responsible with your money.

### **Sunday, April 23, 2023 - Pastor Mike Goldey**

Matthew 25:15-21

If you are faithful over little you will be made ruler over much.

You may not think that you have much...but God can increase it when you bring it. If you don't bring it, it can't be increased.

Think of your "little" a little different. It is BIG...it is IMPORTANT...it is ESSENTIAL.

Psalms 126:1-6

Vs. 1 - "**captivity**" - fortune, or prosperity (their fortunes had been turned)

It is turned based on vs. 6 - precious/best seed.

**NOTE:** Our captivity has already been turned by God's precious seed...we connect to it through ours.

### **Sunday, April 30, 2023 - Jessica Elswick**

Joshua 14:6-12 (NLT)

Caleb seems to be overlooked...a nobody. But in reality he was a strong man of God. He never seemed to waver!

God loves to use the quiet ones!

Even though he wasn't the most talked about...what if everyone was like him?

You may not feel like you are up front and seen by everyone, but God desires and has a plan to use you to bless your family, bless those around you, to be effective in His kingdom.
